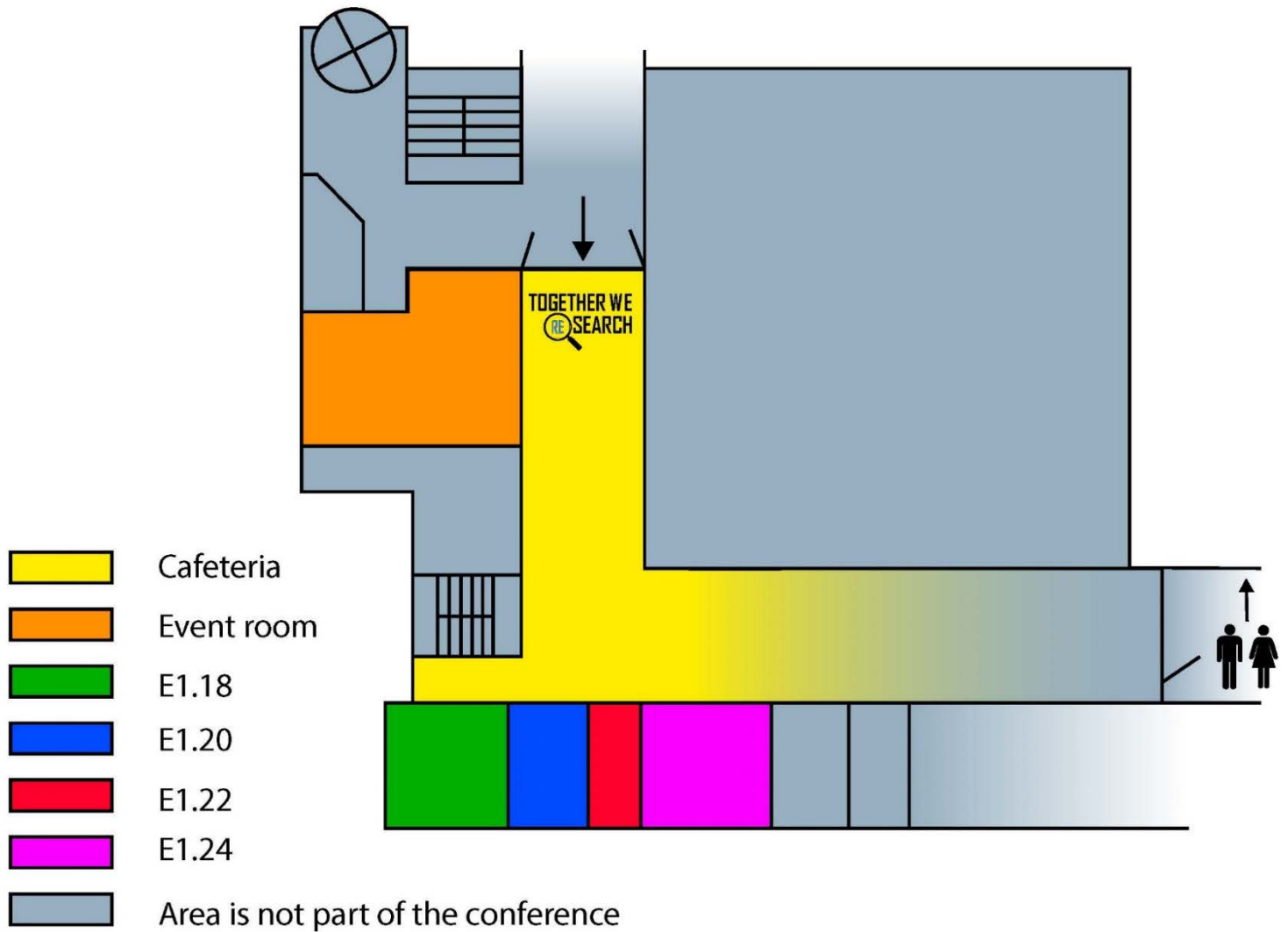

Interactive discussion - E1.24 (Pink)

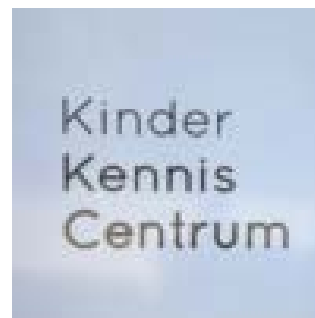
dr. Jaap Bos
